Accessible parking is available near the festival entrance. Please make sure you have your Blue Badge.

### **Site Information**

The festival is in a green field site and is subject to the weather. There is some tracking, but there may be soft and uneven ground. Please don't hesitate to ask if you require any assistance moving across the site.

Please note, the Living History encampments can produce loud noises, smells and smoke.

### **Mobility Scooters**
