

Invite a Friend to Chalke – Competition Terms & Conditions

1. Promoter

2. This competition is promoted by **Chalke History Festivals Ltd** (“the Promoter”).

3. Eligibility

The competition is open to residents of the United Kingdom aged **18 years or over** only, excluding employees of the Promoter, its partners, agents, and anyone professionally connected with the competition.

4. Competition Period

The competition opens at 00:01 on **22 May 2026** and closes at 23:59 on **8 June 2026** (“Closing Date”). Entries received after the Closing Date will not be counted.

5. How to Enter

Eligible entrants may enter by sharing their unique “Bring a Friend to Chalke” referral link.

To qualify, referred friends must complete the sign-up form accessed via that unique referral link. Sign-ups made through any other website form or signup route will not count towards the competition.

Each new individual who signs up via that referral link during the Competition Period will count as one valid referral and one entry into the prize draw for the referrer.

Individuals who join via a referral link (“Referred Friends”) will also each receive one (1) entry into the prize draw.

No purchase is necessary.

5. Multiple Entries

Entrants are encouraged to refer multiple friends. One (1) additional entry will be awarded for each valid referral completed during the Competition Period. There is no maximum number of entries.

6. Valid Referrals

A valid referral is defined as:

- a new individual who was not previously subscribed to the Promoter’s mailing list;

- who completes the referral sign-up form during the Competition Period using a valid referral link; and
- who uses a unique email address.
- Only sign-ups submitted through the designated referral form will be treated as valid referrals.

The Promoter reserves the right to review and disqualify any entries it reasonably believes to be fraudulent, abusive, or intended to manipulate the competition, including but not limited to:

- duplicate sign-ups;
- self-referrals;
- fake or temporary email addresses;
- automated submissions; or
- other suspicious referral activity.

The Promoter's decision regarding the validity of referrals is final.

Winners will be contacted via the email address associated with their festival

subscription account. If a winner does not respond within seven (7) days, the Promoter reserves the right to redraw that prize.

10. Prize Fulfilment

Where necessary, winner details may be shared with relevant prize partners solely for the purpose of prize fulfilment.
